Reference: Removal of Expired of Negotiated Rate Agreements

Dear Mr. Mucci:

On April 2, 2018, Guardian Pipeline, L.L.C. (Guardian) filed tariff records¹ to reflect the removal of six negotiated rate parking and lending agreements with various shippers. Guardian states that no customers were adversely affected by the removal of these service agreements. Waiver of the Commission's 30-day notice requirement is granted and the tariff records referenced in the Appendix are accepted effective April 2 2018, as proposed.

Public notice of the filing was issued on April 3, 2018. Interventions and protests were due as provided in section 154.210 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 154.210 (2016)). Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2016)), all timely filed motions to intervene and any unopposed motion to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted. Granting late intervention at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties. No protests or adverse comments were filed.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as a waiver of the requirements of section 7 of the Natural Gas Act, as amended; nor shall it be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule,

regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your tariff; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against your company.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date this order issues, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713 (2017).
